- School Day 100% Remote Students - 8:30 am log-in for Attendance and Period 1
- School Day 100% Remote Students - **Each grade has different additional log-in times for academic/cluster lessons.**

In-Person Learning Parent Information:

- School Day: In-Person Students ● 8:30 am to 2:00 pm ● Cohort A = Apples ● Cohort B = Blueberries
- First two days ONLY: As in the past, parents may escort their child to the morning line-up spot. After the first two days, students walk on their own to their line-up spot. Parent/Teacher meetings cannot take place at line-up. Arrange for a separate time to speak with the teacher. Be sure to let your child know that although they are lining up in the playground, running around and playing will not take place due to social distancing guidelines. We want our students to gain their independence and develop responsibility for following directions and adhering to school rules/protocols
- We have plenty of P.P.E. supplies (hand sanitizer, disinfectant wipes, gloves, hand soap, etc.)
- Temperature Checks must be done for all prior to arrival. Online Health Screenings should be completed prior to arrival.

- When you do the screening at home, you or your child just need to provide the results of the screening either by showing the email on a smartphone or a printout of the results before entering the school building.
- Paper Health Screening Questionnaires forms will also be available at school.
- Parents are asked to check their child's temperature and ask how they are feeling, BEFORE leaving your home.
- Name Tags must be worn. Use a large adhesive mailing label or an index card hole punched with yarn/string, etc.
- Thermometer distribution at 8:30 AM line-up and 2:00 PM pick-up.
